

### Interesting Facts about the Caucasus

- The Caucasus is a region located at the border of Europe and Asia, between the Caspian and Black Seas. Europe's highest peak, Mount Elbrus, is located here at 18,510 feet (5,642 metres).
- The name Caucasus comes from the Scythian Language and means "White with snow".
- Prometheus, the Titan from a Greek myth who created mankind, stole fire from Mount Olympus and gifted it to humans. Zeus became angry over this and, as a punishment, chained Prometheus to the mountain range.
- Jason sailed to the west coast of the Caucasus while he was searching for his Golden Fleece. There he met Princess Medea, granddaughter of the sun god, Helios.
- The 2014 Winter Olympics were held in the Caucasus Mountains, in Sochi, Russia.
- Many ethnic groups inhabit the mountain ranges, and there is a wide variety of different languages.

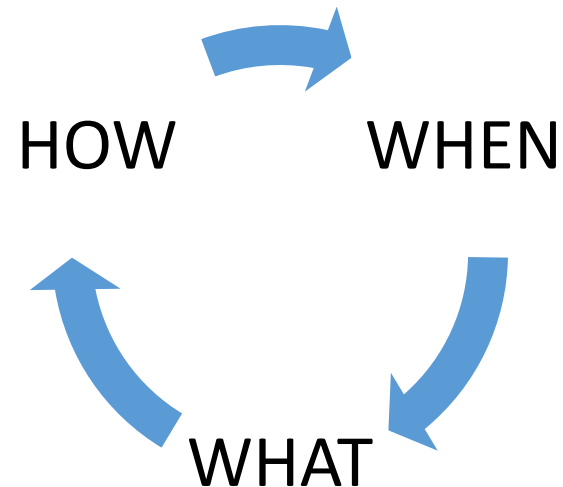
